

Lesson 25

God's New and Perfect World

[This chapter is based on Revelation, Chapter 21]

The first two chapters of the Bible tell how God created the world and describe the paradise home He made for man to enjoy eternally. The third chapter tells of the rebellion and expulsion of man from his paradise home. In the last two chapters of the Bible-in the Book of Revelation-we are given a view of God's plan to restore this planet to a glorious paradise for those who love and follow Him.

What an exciting future God promises His people on earth! Our fondest dreams and hopes will be realized when our heavenly Father restores the dominion lost by Adam and Eve. Let's study about that future.

READ: Revelation 21:1 - 22:5.
